Patrick Collings has advised that the Western Cape Provincial Sports Confederation has continued to engage regarding the amendments and there may be further opportunity to state opposition points. There have been no further engagements noted across other provinces or via SASCOC. We have previously aligned with SASCOC's submissions made in January 2020 and forwarded to council ahead of the provincial roadshows last year, and continue to support this. SASCOC was also instructed by the General Assembly in May to tackle this matter more determinedly. We shall be in the lookout for further announcements regarding opportunities to make submissions.
